The vineyard:

The Ungsteiner Weilberg is one of the most historic vineyards of the Palatinate. Almost 2000 years ago Roman settlers founded a winery and by doing so they brought viticulture to the region. The heart of the Weilberg, which is called in common parlance „Red Earth“, is a unique vineyard.

The soil:

The soil of the Weilberg consists of a loamy clay with some limestones in it. The high content of haematit (Fe_2O_3) brings out a type of soil which is called „terra rossa“ (red earth).

The wine:

For the 2018 WEILBERG only the best grapes were selected by hand, pressed gently and fermented slowly over several months. Due to this aroma-protecting vinification and the long lie-contact, the natural taste of the grapes could be preserved and the wine now reveals its distinctive terroir flavours.

The 2018 WEILBERG shows flavours of sage and wild herbs. On the palate the wine has a wonderful complexity, shows hints of spiciness and is obviously influenced by the long lie-contact. The lovely integrated acidity and the powerful, but elegant body are another proof of a wine of big potential (drinkability up to at least 2033).
