Terroir: The Karthäuserhofberg faces south by southwest and covers almost 20 hectares. It stretches up to 254 meters above sea level with gradients of up to 55%. The unique microclimate of the area, plus the distinctive Devonian slate in the soil, has created the ideal combination for producing unforgettable Rieslings.
The grapes were carefully selected from our monopole vineyard, the Karthäuserhofberg.

Vinification: The grapes were carefully brought to the cellar and then directly put on the press. The fermentation took place under a controlled temperature of 16-19 °C in stainless steel. The 2003 Spätlese was filtered and bottled in April 2004.

Description: An example par excellence for a Ruwer-Auslese – noble matured in the historical deep cellar, it starts to show now its full aging potential. Dried and candied fruits, wild honey, lively, fresh, intense with a long finish; elegance and harmony.
