Winemaking details	

The Kabinett grapes were hand harvested in the second week of October in our second selective picking run. After immediate pressing, 50% of must was fermented with indigenous yeast, the other 50% of must fermented with added yeasts, all in small stainless steel tanks. The fermentation was cool-stopped. The young wine spent 3 months on lees, after which it was bottled in May 2022.

### About the Winery

The Mönchhof estate is mentioned first as belonging of the Cistercian abbey of Himmerod in the Eifel in 1177. 1804, after the Secularisation under Napoleon the Eymael family bought the estate on an auction in Paris from the French state. The Mönchhofs top-sites Ürziger Würzgarten, Erdener Prälät, and Erdener Treppchen are planted to 100% Riesling with mostly original European rootstocks. Some of the wines are up to 120 years-old producing some of the finest berries.

### Vintage Notes

Eventhough 2021 was a wet and cold year our excellent vineyards in the Ürziger Würzgarten, Erdener Treppchen and Erdener Prälät have given us ripe, healthy grapes. Also the acid values in our locations were not as high as in other locations of the Mosel. The great strength of the steep slope vineyards is to capture enough heat and sunlight for the vines even in cool years. That is why Würzgarten, Treppchen and Prälät have been considered Grand Crus of the Mosel for centuries.

### Tasting Notes

Bright floral aromas, yellow pear, paired with subtle notes of spicy red currant. Light and vibrant with more pear and apple on the palate. Mineral grip and just the right balance between acidity and fruitiness.

### Vineyard Notes

Ürziger Würzgarten, steep vineyard with volcanic red soil and red slate, average vine age 80 years

### Pairing Notes

Good with white fish, poultry and spicy dishes, on its own this Kabinett will restore your spirits after a long day.
