**Cuvée Katharina**  
- TRADITION -

**TASING NOTE**

This is a structured but fine Blanc de Noirs sparkling wine made out of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. Cuvée Katharina is named after the younger daughter of Volker and Heide-Rose Raumland. The elegance of Pinot Noir is combined with the strength and fruit of Pinot Meunier. It develops subtle smoky notes, combined with walnut and brioche as well as fruity notes of dark berries and light floral hints. The Sekt is puristic (Brut Nature) but has also a creamy and crisp texture at the same time due to its vinification both in stainless-steel tanks as well as old barrique barrels.
