**Cuvée Marie-Luise**

**TASTING NOTE**

An elegant Blanc de Noirs Cuvée, that was traditionally named after the first daughter Marie-Luise. The grapes (100% Pinot Noir) come from our vineyards in Flörsheim-Dalsheim (Rheinhessen). Flörsheim-Dalsheim is characterised by very interesting soils that mainly contain lime stone and clay. Those soils give the cuvée a charming complexity and fine aromas. The taste is characterized by delicate fruit, especially small red berries. This sparkling wine is complemented by fine spice, saltiness and a flattering interplay of fruit-sweetness and acidity.
