About the Winery

For centuries, our family has been making wine along the Rhine on the legendary Grand Cru sites of the famed Roter Hang. Working with warm Rheinhessen vineyards that range from steep to steeper, we are proud to cultivate biodynamic Riesling and Pinot Noir on organic-certified sites in the dry-farmed landscape between Bodenheim and Oppenheim. Since 2006, I have managed my family estate together with my husband. I'm a nature lover, oenologist, businesswoman and mother of two.

Vintage Notes

After three sun-drenched vintages - 2018, 2019 and 2020 - the 2021 vintage gave us reason to think back to times gone by. In terms of weather conditions, 2021 can best be compared to the 2002 vintage, which also produced magnificent Riesling qualities, but which were only possible through intensive manual work and nerve-racking waiting. In 2021, the harvest dragged on well into November before the window of opportunity for healthy grapes for dry wines closed again in Rheinhessen.

Tasting Notes

Pettenthal shimmers pale straw yellow in the glass, echoing its stony chiseled character against sublime spice. Complex and nuanced, like a grand red wine, it needs time in the glass to reveal its full potential. The fruit appears as almost an afterthought, reduced to

Vineyard Notes

Pettenthal is our first historic site on the Roter Hang, situated at an elevation of 90 - 170 meters. With gradients measuring up to 70%, it is the steepest parcel in all of Rheinhessen. In the late 80s, in a time of
