Winemaking details

The QVINTERRA® Riesling feinherb comes primarily from our vineyards in Nierstein. Two batches broke off fermentation on their own, imbuing the overall spicy-mineral aromas of red slate with a subtle sweetness. Matured in stainless steel and wild yeast fermented.

About the Winery

For centuries, our family has been making wine along the Rhine on the legendary Grand Cru sites of the famed Roter Hang. Working with warm Rheinhessen vineyards that range from steep to steeper, we are proud to cultivate biodynamic Riesling and Pinot Noir on organic-certified sites in the dry-farmed landscape between Bodenheim and Oppenheim. Since 2006, I have managed my family estate together with my husband. I'm a nature lover, oenologist, businesswoman and mother of two.

Vintage Notes

After three sun-drenched vintages - 2018, 2019 and 2020 - the 2021 vintage gave us reason to think back to times gone by. In terms of weather conditions, 2021 can best be compared to the 2002 vintage, which also produced magnificent Riesling qualities, but which were only possible through intensive manual work and nerve-racking waiting. In 2021, the harvest dragged on well into November before the window of opportunity for healthy grapes for dry wines closed again in Rheinhessen.

Tasting Notes

Shimmering in the glass, with notes of yellow stone and orchard fruit, reminiscent of peach and apples in the orchard. Structured in spice, with nuttiness and a mild herbal character that herald its juicy Riesling character. The ripe red-cheeked apple fruit, reminiscent of RubINETTE, is balanced against the savory flavors of its red rock origins, offering joyful, fruity enjoyment.

Vineyard Notes

The grapes for the QVINTERRA® collection hail from Oppenheim, Nierstein, Nackenheim, Bodenheim and Laubenheim, with pristine fruit reflective of the diverse vineyards along the Rhine.

Pairing Notes

Pairs outstandingly with hearty everyday cuisine, from liverwurst sandwiches or potato soup to salads with fish or meat and a fruity dressing.
