### About the Winery

Weingüter Wegeler is a family-run business founded in 1882. The fourth generation of the Wegeler family continues the long tradition, supported by Ralf Frenzel as speaker of the owner families. All operations are run by managing director Richard Grosche. Weingüter Wegeler has two winery sites on the Rhine and Mosel rivers, all of which focus on Riesling. In 2007, the addition of the 5-hectare Krone estate at Assmannshausen contributed a small but fine share of Pinot Noir to the line-up.

### Vintage Notes

A very mild year with little rainfall- very warm and dry, radiant! Budding was on April 24 and ripening began on August 17. The harvest took place from mid-September and the end of October... The wines are dense, intense and have a well-balanced acidity. Great potential for aging!

### Tasting Notes

Brilliant amber color, candied papaya, tumeric, a hint of ginger, a hint of sweetness, fresh but perfectly ripe acidity. We recommend serving this wine with oven roasted saddle of venison. You will be surprised

### Vineyard Notes

A cuvée from our good to very good locations in the Middle Moselle in Berncastel, Wehlen and Graach. No purchased wines are used for this wine (as for all Wegeler wines), only selfproduced grapes from our own vineyards.

### Pairing Notes

Hearty cheesecake with honey cucumbers, mustard seed cherries and rye caraway chips
