About the Winery

Weingüter Wegeler is a family-run business founded in 1882. The fourth generation of the Wegeler family continues the long tradition, supported by Ralf Frenzel as speaker of the owner families. All operations are run by managing director Richard Grosche. Weingüter Wegeler has two winery sites on the Rhine and Mosel rivers, all of which focus on Riesling. In 2007, the addition of the 5-hectare Krone estate at Assmannshausen contributed a small but fine share of Pinot Noir to the line-up.

Vintage Notes

A mild spring was followed by a hot summer and the grapes were able to develop well. The Riesling harvest began on October 10 and lasted until early November. We were able to harvest good qualities with a lot of extract and minerality. Due to noble botrytis, even Beerenauslese and a Trockenbeerenauslese were possible. As a crowning finale, we were able to harvest ice wine on December 5.

Tasting Notes

Clear golden yellow slight viscosity. Mature, distinguished, noble gentleman. Fresh and fragrant, finely grape-like noble berries, present-fresh but not prominent acidity, delicate and beautiful notes of caramelized orange and tangerine. Full-bodied and serious in the cheeks. A worthy representative from the best family.

Vineyard Notes

The rather small single site Bernkasteler Graben with its 12ha is in the immediate vicinity of the Bernkasteler Doctor. Orientation south-southwest with up to 60% slope.
