About the Winery

Weingüter Wegeler is a family-run business founded in 1882. The fourth generation of the Wegeler family continues the long tradition, supported by Ralf Frenzel as speaker of the owner families. All operations are run by managing director Richard Grosche. Weingüter Wegeler has two winery sites on the Rhine and Mosel rivers, all of which focus on Riesling. In 2007, the addition of the 5-hectare Krone estate at Assmannshausen contributed a small but fine share of Pinot Noir to the line-up.

Vintage Notes

Drought, turbo harvest and top qualities. After a warm and sunny spring, the vines already showed the first green shoots in April. Just in time for the Ice Saints in mid-May, however, the weather turned frosty once again, causing severe frost damage and considerable yield losses. The vines developed their blossoms as early as the end of May - eight to ten days ahead of the average of the last 30 years. Accordingly, the main wine harvest started early in many growing regions, as early as the end of August.

Tasting Notes

A clear, refined and elegant, deep, dense and lovely complex bouquet of bright fruits with notes of crushed stones and herbs (mint). Intense and seriously structured, this is a full-bodied, complex and sustainably saline dry Riesling with ripe, elegant fruit and remarkable finesse. The finish is very long, intense and persistently salty.

Vineyard Notes

Produced since 1983, the 2020 Rheingau Riesling trocken Geheimrat "J" is a top dry Riesling that assembles the fruit from these grand cru vineyards: Geiseheimer Rothenberg, Oestricher Lenchen, Doosberg, Rudesheimer Berg Rottland and Berg Roseneck
