Classification:
VDP.GUTSWEIN

Grape Variety:
100% Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir)

Origin:
Estate grown grapes from the village of Kallstadt

Vineyard Work:
Buckwheat, radish and clover penetrate the soil and attract useful animals. Horse dung fertilizes the soil naturally. Suckers removed in spring and careful leave removal during summer.

Vinification:
Hand harvested, carefully selected and destemmed. Wild yeast fermented after a short maceration; some whole clusters included. Aged in used and new barriques for 15 months.
No filtration, no fining.

Character:
Elegant, fresh Pinot Noir

Alcohol 13,0 % vol. Residual Sugar: 0,1 g/L Acidity 6,2 g/L
